In 1958, the Sumeire family who have owned the Font-Freye estate since 1933, acquired this large estate near Pierrefeu du Var, in Provence. Formerly the summer residence of the archbishops of Toulon, this property bears two names inherited from its long past. Château la Tour de l'Evêque and Château la Tour Sainte Anne. An exceptional valley planted with vines surrounded by the Maures hills.







# CHÂTEAU BARBEYROLLES

Barbeyrolles was acquired in 1977 by Régine Sumeire. This twelve hectare vineyard located at the foot of the village in Gassin, is a preserved spot of magical beauty in the gulf of Saint-Tropez.

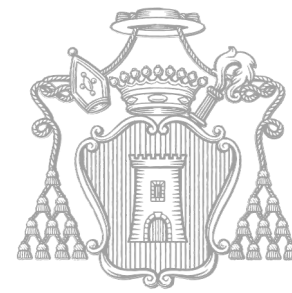






# TERROIRS

In the valley of the Maurettes the land Schisteux of the Phyllades of Hyères consists of shaley soil derived from Silurian layers, and Permian red sandstone.

*The vines covering 83 hectares, are on average twenty years old.*

The coastal land of Château Barbeyrolles is located in the Maures hills. All twelve hectares have shaley soils dating back to the Paleozoic era.


*The vines covering 12 hectares, are on average thirty years old.*

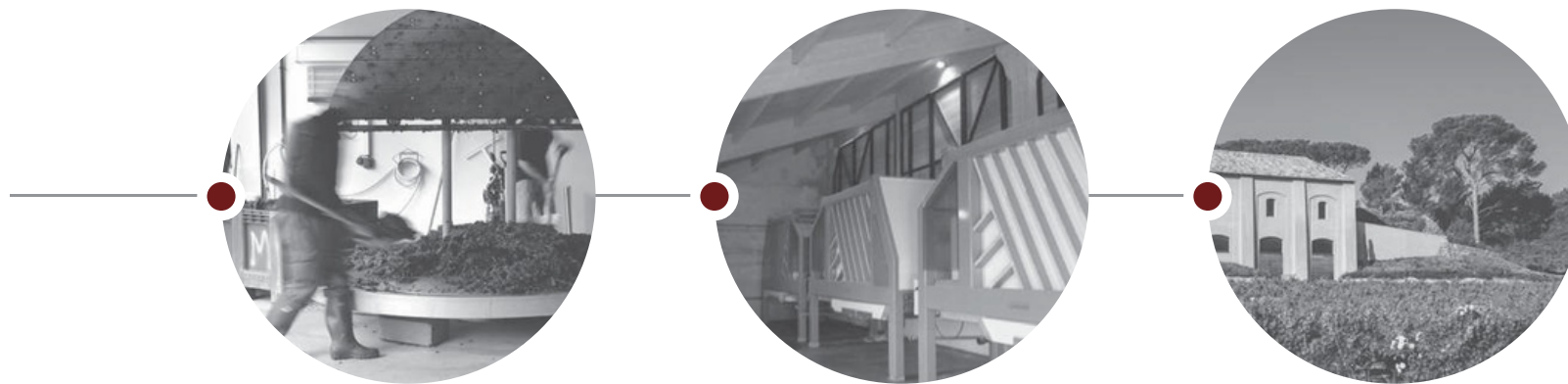

# Pétale de Rose

**TWO ESTATES : A UNIQUE WINEMAKING STYLE**

Once upon a time, a young winemaker wanted to create a pale rosé wine. She had the idea to vinify red grenache by pressing the entire grapes using a champanese press.

The resulting juice that flew from the press had a pale color. The difference was noticeable with a deeper than usual length in the mouth.

This is how "Pétale de Rose" was born in 1985 at Château Barbeyrolles, the second estate owned by Régine Sumeire. In 1988, she decided to replicate it at Château La Tour de L'Évêque. Pétale de Rose was recognized as the first pale rosé in Provence.

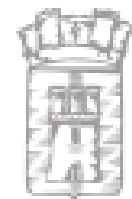
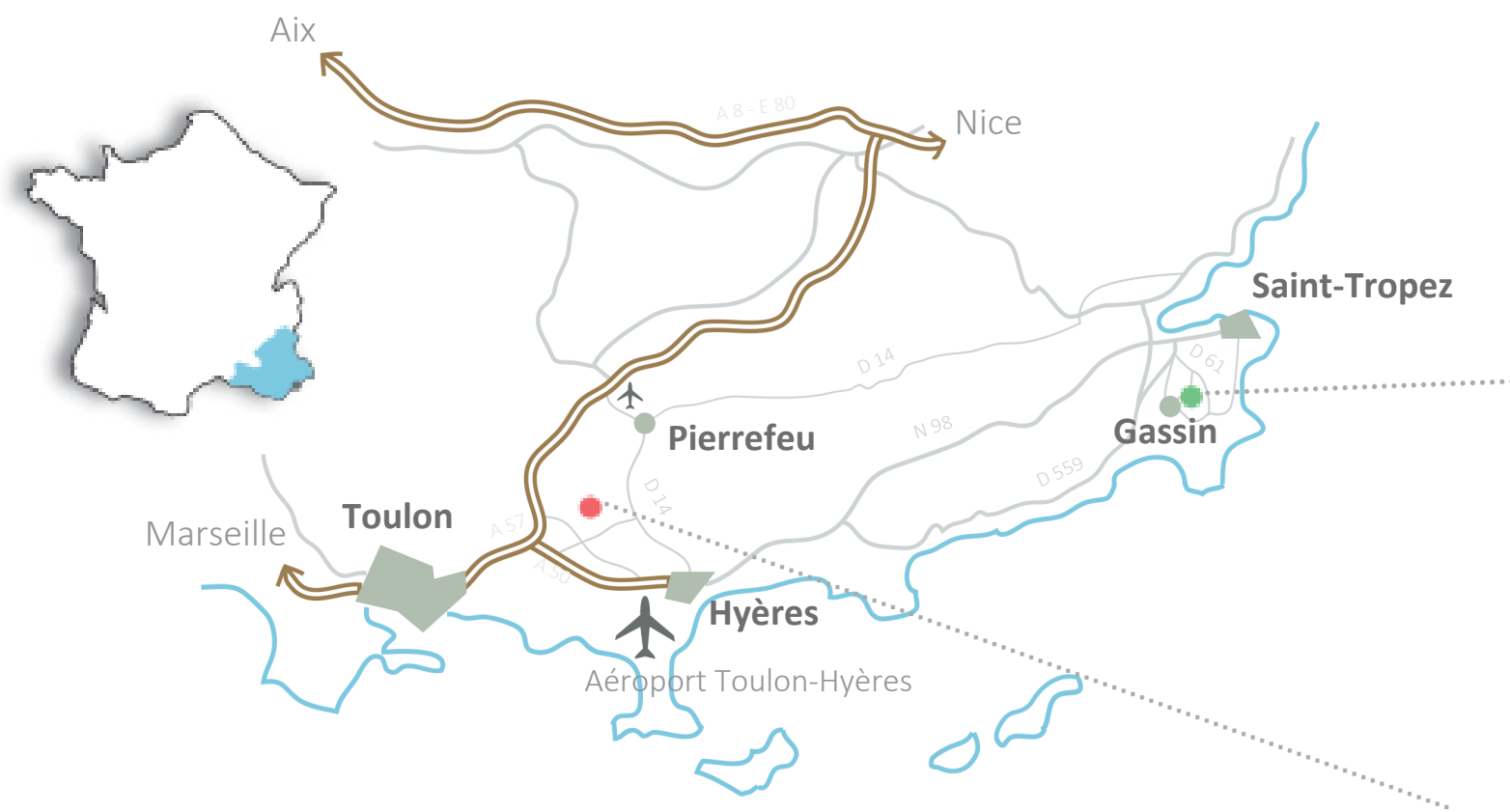










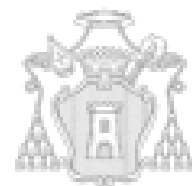
